- (i) Within 7 days please send a further letter to the practitioner enclosing a copy of the first letter and requesting the practitioner's response within a further 7 days.
- (ii) If the practitioner again fails to respond within that time limit, please report to me in writing forthwith setting out all relevant details and attaching copies of the relevant correspondence. I will then give further directions.
- 4. At the conclusion of the investigation I request that you forward me the file together with a memorandum in the form annexed including draft reasons for decision.

I may give further directions pursuant to section 4.4.9(4) during the course of the investigation.

The complainant and the practitioner have been advised of this referral.
