call I meant that the contract given had been carried out. [REDACTED] had been successfully executed. Even though I mentioned George, to my knowledge he didn't know what was going on. I wanted to see him so I could tell him all the details of what had happened and also I was broke at the time and wanted to get paid.

66. After the call I asked [REDACTED] if he could give me a lift either to Carl's or to my place to get my car. We finished cleaning up and left in [REDACTED] van. He had the police scanner still going in the van. We were driving towards the city along the [REDACTED] and near the intersection with [REDACTED] we were intercepted by the Special Operations Group and arrested.

67. I was then taken back to the St Kilda Road Police Station where I was interviewed, charged and remanded at the Custody Centre.

68. While I was at the custody centre I was visited by my barrister Nicola GOBBO. I asked her to pass on a message to Carl and Tony and I rubbed my fingers together and mentioned [REDACTED]. This action was referring to getting the money from Tony to go to [REDACTED] so she could be taken care of. Nicola wrote a note and put it to the screen. Although I don't remember the exact wording it said words to the effect that she would be seeing them that day.

69. A couple of days later I spoke to Carl WILLIAMS. He was actually at [REDACTED] address. During this call either [REDACTED] or him told me that he had given [REDACTED] some money. I later discovered that it was only \$1500. I have not received any more of the money promised.
