I was a member of the Victorian Police Force from 1985 to 2007. I worked at the Drug Squad from 1996 to 2002.

[REDACTED] is a prolific heroin dealer and violent offender by the name of [REDACTED] had previously provided information to me regarding a drug dealer call [REDACTED] along with a mobile phone number. He stated [REDACTED] wanted to buy [REDACTED]. This meeting was a follow up meeting to get some more information. I was in company with Ian Ferguson who later submitted an information report regarding this meeting.
