I have been served with an 8A by Galbally Rolfe on behalf of Faruk ORMAN re the murder of PEIRCE. (Committal Mention is on 1 Oct, Committal likely Feb 08)

The OPP has advised that we should be handing over (subject to PII claims on police methodology etc) all IR's, statements and other relevant materials relating to the investigation of the GIBBONS/NEASEY/CEKOVIC group of suspects.

Naturally this would 1) put [REDACTED] at risk and 2) provide the defence with an alternative theory to put to the jury.

Do you have a view on this before we start collating the material?
