purpose of taking part in an interview. DALE stated he would not accompany us unless he was arrested and BEZZINA then informed DALE that he was under arrest. At 6.33 a.m. I left DALE's house in company with BEZZINA, FOREHAN and DALE and then returned to the Homicide Squad Offices.

On arrival at the Homicide Squad offices DALE was placed in an interview room. DALE was then interviewed by BEZZINA and myself. The interview was commenced at 7.34 a.m. and concluded at 8.14 a.m. At the completion of the interview DALE was released without charge and arrangements were made for DALE to be conveyed home by a friend of his – Eddie FORMOSA. The video recorded interview I now produce is an accurate recording of the interview with DALE which took place on 17 May 2004.

I then conducted a number of inquiries and continued my duties.

On Wednesday 26 May 2004 at 3.05 p.m. I attended at 2/87 Harp Road East Kew with BEZZINA. There I met with the deceased's daughter Mandy HODSON and Michael ROSE. During discussions with Mandy HODSON she informed us that her brother Andrew had removed her father's handgun from her parent's premises on the night of discovering their bodies. As a result, on Thursday 27 May 2004 at 8.00 a.m. BEZZINA and I attended at Street, Brunswick and spoke to Andrew HODSON. There I received from Andrew HODSON the following:

- One .45 calibre handgun (FSD Case no. 9250/034 Item 58)
- One handgun magazine containing .45 calibre ammunition (FSD Case no. 9250/034 Item 59)
- One fired .22 calibre cartridge case (FSD Case no. 9250/034 Item 60)

Andrew HODSON informed me that he had received the fired .22 calibre cartridge case from Mandy HODSON the previous evening and she had told him that she had located it at her parent's house in the room where his parent's bodies had been discovered following her meeting with me the previous day.

I then returned to the Homicide Squad offices where the items I had received from Andrew HODSON were entered into the Property Book. At 10.40 a.m. I attended at
