I make this statement of my own free will.

On ~~Sunday~~ ^{Monday} 24 April 2006 I was [REDACTED] Detective Sergeant Dale Flynn. I was aware that police were monitoring my movements and recording my conversation at the time.

At 2.16 pm I after pre arranging an appointment I met with Mr Bickley in the Avondale Heights area. We discussed the following,


- Mr Bickley is willing to press MDMA (ecstasy) powder for me at \$3 per tablet.
- Mr Bickley will not do pressing in stages and he wants all the product at once.
- That I have 10 kilos of ecstasy power ready. (This is not true but I have precursor chemicals able to make 10 kilos). He wanted 50 kilograms all at once.
- Conversation re Mr Bickley previous relationship with Tony Mokbel and current relationship with Milad and Horty Mokbel.
- Mr Bickley still has a pill press belonging to the Mokbels.
- Mr Bickley has a contact who can supply pill presses.
- Will make approximately 10,000 tablets per kilogram.
- Discussed methods used to bind tablets.
- Discussed sale price of tablets and receiving percentage.
- Discussed receiving some money up front from me to allow the purchase of pill press.
- Discussed when the product would be supplied.

This meeting concluded at 2.46 pm. A short time after this I left this location and PII [REDACTED] Detective Sergeant Flynn.

I am with Mr Cooper more detailed statement in relation to these conversations at a future time.


