Victoria Police has reviewed the provision of assistance for prosecution witnesses following the recent decision of Justice Mullins in the Supreme Court of Queensland, *RT v Moti* [2009] QSC 407. Note, the references to abuse of process and bringing the administration of justice into disrepute in paragraph 72 of the judgement.

It is now clear that the proposed arrangements relating to the taxation affairs of your client's father are no longer an option for Victoria police if your client is to remain a witness. In addition, any future application for financial assistance relating to family members would be unlikely to be considered appropriate for a criminal prosecution.

The arrangements with the Australian Taxation office will be ceased forthwith. Please contact me if this letter requires further clarification.
