7 Mr Foreman and members of the jury, I understand you have a
8 verdict. My Associate will take it from you.

9 FOREMAN: Yes, we do, Your Honour.

10 (At 11.25 a.m. the jury returned a verdict of guilty.) HER HONOUR: Ladies and gentlemen, may I, on behalf of the 11 community and all of those in court, and particularly 12 13 myself, say thank you. What you have been asked to do is a very onerous task and the community owes you a great debt. 14 Jury service is possibly the most important thing you will 15 ever do in terms of your civic obligations as citizens and 16 we do understand it is hard. On behalf of the community, 17 as I said, and myself in particular, thank you, you worked 18 very hard, you paid very careful attention so thank you. 19 You are excused. If anyone needs to be excused from any 20 further jury service for any period of time I will allow 21 22 that. If you go with Mr Beaumont he will make 23 arrangements about what occurs from here. (At 11.26 a.m. the jury left the court.) 24 25 Mr Heliotis, at what point would you like to make a plea? MR HELIOTIS: Some time this week, I suppose. I understand that 26 before the Court of Appeal next week - - -27 28 HER HONOUR: If it is possible to do it this week I would prefer

29 it. I anticipate I will be starting another matter next 30 week.

31 MR HELIOTIS: What about Friday?
